Dec 27 – Feb 20	Signatures-in-Lieu of Filing Fee Period (EC 8106)
Jan 31	Semi Annual Campaign Statement Filing Deadline (GC 84200, 84218)
Jan 27 – Feb 5	Judicial Candidate Statement of Intent Period (EC8023) Incumbents must file within this time period.
Feb 6 – Feb 10	Judicial Candidate Statement of Intent Extension Period (EC8023(b)) NON-INCUMBENTS ONLY. If the incumbent fails to file a Statement of intent, the period shall extend for any non-incumbents to file until the first day to file nomination papers.
Feb 10 – Mar 7	Nomination Period. (EC8020) Time period for filing nomination papers and declaration of candidacy. Incumbents MUST file by March 7. Call the Elections Division at 781-5228 to make an appointment
Feb 12	Deadline for Voter Information Guide- Statewide Candidates)
Mar 8 - Mar 12	Extension of Nomination Period for NON-INCUMBENTS ONLY. (EC8022 & 8024) DOES NOT APPLY WHERE THERE IS NO INCUMBENT DUE TO TERM LIMITS OR REDISTRICTING
Mar 10	Last Day to withdraw Candidate Statement of Qualifications by 5:00 p.m. for contests closing on March 7 th (EC13307(a)(3))
Mar 13	Last Day to withdraw Candidate Statement of Qualifications by 5:00 p.m. for contests closing on March 12 th (EC13307(a)(3))
Mar 13	Random Alphabet Drawing
Mar 24	Pre-Election Campaign Statement Due (GC 84200-5, 84200.7(a))
Apr 7 – May 20	Write-in Candidate Period (EC8601)
May 5	First day vote-by-mail ballots are available. Last day to register to vote to receive State Voter Information Guide and County sample ballot booklet (EC 3001, 3003)
May 19	Close of Registration. Voters registering between May 6 and May 19 th will receive notification of their polling place but will not receive any other voter information. (EC2102, 2107)
May 22	Pre-Election campaign statement due (GC 84200-5, 84200.7(a))
May 27	Last day for vote by mail ballot to be MAILED to a voter (EC3001)
June 3	Election Day
July 1	Complete Official canvass
July 31	Semi-Annual Campaign Statement Due
