Shaun Cooper Reported: The Bob Jones pathway project N.E.P.A documents are being amended by Caltrans. County Parks is working concurrently on Request for Proposal (RFP) for additional phases of Bob Jones Trail. The ATP grant application has been previously submitted. Awaiting to here for approval for grant funds in order to complete the first section of construction of Bob Jones Trail.

In regards to the Morro Bay to Cayucos connector project, consultant is working on Chevron's consent of land owner for establishment of Coastal Development Permit. Will be coordinating with Chevron to initiate next steps in project.

For the Templeton to Atascadero connector project, the environmental studies are being finished as well as archaeological studies are being done at project location.

II. SLOCOG

Jeff Brubaker is absent for this meeting. Dale well read reports from SLOCOG on behalf of Jeff.

Dale Sutliff Reported (for SLOCOG): SR-227 Operation Study is in draft form. Final draft will be presented to SLOCOG board in October. With consideration of approval or adoption expected in December. Study includes recommendations for short term bike/ped improvements including building the Edna/Price Canyon Trail. Also includes recommendation of lighting, pedestrian crossing and rumble strip installations. These improvements are for the SR-227 vicinity from Airport Road to Los Ranchos Road.

III. Caltrans

a. Highway 46 West Rumble Strips

Cathy Degrassi Reported: Upcoming rumble strip project on Highway 46 West. The project limits will be a little over 20 miles in length of edge line rumble strips to be placed at various locations along the route. This project is based on the run off the road collisions that Caltrans has studied. There will be a minimum of 5 feet shoulder required at locations which are recommended for edge line rumble strips. Beginning of construction will initiate in fall of 2017, however if funding is provided sooner, construction will be initiated in summer of 2017. The total duration of construction will take about two months or 30 workings days to be finished.

Motion by Ken: Motion is to support the proposal for rumblestrips on fog line. Seconded by Josh. All in favor.

IV. County Public Works

Yama Mohabbat Reported:

a. Bike Plan

Bike plan went to the Board of Supervisors today (8/9/16) and was approved unanimously by the board.

William Van Orden has resigned from District 1. The clerk has been notified and vacancy for the position has been posted.

b. Surface Treatment Projects

The surface treatment projects are continuing throughout the county. Bike Lanes to be installed on Thompson Ave. from Nipomo High School to Highway 101. Price Canyon will be completed by an estimated construction completion date of March 2017.

c. Grant Applications

SSARP Grant application has been approved and county is funded with \$120,000 for the study of gravel roads and Roadway Signing & Striping Audit (RSSA) for the top 10 rural roads of concern.

HSIP grant application deadline is Friday August 12th. County is applying for 4 different projects. The projects are Los Berros bike lane from Avis to 2/3 miles east, lighting at LOVR, Thompson, and Pomeroy, metal beam guardrail at Burton Drive and pedestrian cross walks with in roadway warning lights at Ontario, Ocean, and Tefft street. Set-Aside funds will be applied for the metal beam guardrail and in roadway warning lights.

Dale comment: Next item is section 1.2 which is related to a terminology issue, Michelle stated she changed the terminology to "implement"

Motion: Dale- All those in favor of terminology change to "implement". All in favor of motion. Motion Approved.

Dale Comment: Section 1.6, proposal is that staff identify deficiencies and any improvements that are needed.1.6 Proposal is to revise wording. Matthews recommendation makes sense to combine 1.4,1.5,1.6 into one item.

Michelle comment: 5.2 amend the bac bylaws.

Dale comment: stated it should be up to staff where it places.

Motion: Dale stated motion, "Go to Bimonthly with staff deciding which policy it will fall under." (Goal to change the bylaws) Seconded by Skip. 5 in favor, and 3 opposed. Motion was in favor.
