

## IMPORTANT DATES FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION

DATE	EVENT
<b>October 5, 2020</b>	<p><b>29 Day Close of Registration</b> Must be registered by this date in order to receive a State Voter Information Guide</p>
<b>October 19, 2020</b>	<p><b>15 Day Close of Registration</b> Last day to <b>register to</b> vote. If already registered, it is the last day for a voter to send in a request for a change residence address</p> <p>Voters registering October 5th – October 19th will receive a Vote-by-Mail ballot, but will not receive a State Voter information Guide</p>
<b>October 20, 2020– November 3, 2020</b>	<p>Voter can “<b>conditionally</b>” register and vote at our office or Voter Service Center after the 15-day voter registration deadline</p> <p>If already registered, the voter can fill out a Change of Address form in our office or Voter Service Center. The voter <b>must</b> appear in person</p>
<b>October 27, 2020</b>	<p>Last Day for elections office to mail out 2<sup>nd</sup> requested Vote-by-Mail ballots</p> <p>Voters must submit a 2<sup>nd</sup> Ballot Request application or call our office for a 2<sup>nd</sup> Ballot Request by this date to be mailed a 2<sup>nd</sup> ballot</p> <p>Voters may still come into the office to get a ballot up to and on Election Day, November 3, 2020</p>
<b>October 31, 2020 November 2, 2020</b>	<p>Voter Service Centers are open from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm</p>
<b>November 3, 2020</b>	<p><b>ELECTION DAY</b> – Voter Service Centers are open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm</p>
<b>November 20, 2020</b>	<p>Last Day to receive Vote-by-mail ballots– must be postmarked by November 3, 2020 and received in our office within 17 days after the election</p>
