MAY 22 EC §10509	District Secretary submits Resolution to the County Elections Official Requesting Special Election to place a tax measure before the voters.
JUNE 4	County Elections Official takes request to the Board of Supervisors.
JUNE 8 EC §9163, 9316	BY THIS DATE the Elections Official shall send the Notice of Election and Notice Calling for Submission of arguments FOR or AGAINST the measure to be published.
JUNE 14 EC §9316	PRIMARY ARGUMENTS DUE LAST DAY for proponent(s) to change or withdraw Primary Arguments.
JUNE 14 EC §9313	IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS DUE from County Counsel. FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT DUE from Auditor (if directed by B.O.S.) TAX RATE STATEMENT DUE (Bond Measures only)
JUNE 15 - 24 EC §9380	PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD - Primary Arguments, Impartial Analysis. Tax Rate Statement & Fiscal Impact Statement.
JUNE 21 EC §9317	REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS DUE - File with the County Elections Official. LAST DAY for proponent(s) to change or withdraw Rebuttal Arguments.
JUNE 22 - JULY 1 EC §9380	PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD - For Rebuttals Only.
JULY 29	First day Vote by Mail Ballots are available
AUG 13 - 27 EC §2170	Conditional Voter Registration Period – Those not registered must come to the Office of the Elections Official to register to vote and obtain a ballot.
AUG 20	Last day for Elections Office to mail Vote-by-Mail Ballots to voters. (EC §3001)
AUG 27	Election Day. Election Office will be open at 7:00am and close at 8:00pm.
AUG 30	Last day to receive ballots postmarked on or before Aug 27 by 5:00 PM
SEPT 4 EC §3019(f)(1)(A)(ii)	Last day to submit Unsigned Ballot Statement and Signature Verification Statement by 5:00 PM
SEPT 6	Complete Official Canvass
