Dear Board:

We received notification via letter sent March 17, 2015 that the above-named inmate is being considered for early parole release after serving 50% of his sentence. We object because he is unsuitable and would present a substantial danger to public safety if released now.

Inmate Pinon was convicted of second degree burglary and possession of credit card counterfeiting equipment in case #F458733, with a prior strike for first degree burglary. He was given a six-year sentence in February 2012. He should not be eligible for parole until late 2016. When he committed this crime, was on parole in Region IV from a prior prison term and was found in a motel in Los Angeles with a fraudulent credit card, while out on bail in this case.

His behavior in prison has been abysmal and illustrates he is unsuitable for early release.

It is our position that he needs to serve the sentence he was given. He poses a serious risk to public safety and should not be given the benefits of early release on parole.
