
# Key Updates to Draft Chapter 9

- Clarifying that pumping reductions will be required and enforced where necessary to stabilize groundwater levels and avoid undesirable results.
- Clarifying that there are different options for achieving the required reductions that individual entities may choose to implement.
- Clarifying that the details of voluntary and mandatory actions to achieve the reductions would be developed concurrently after GSP adoption.
- Clarifying that projects are concepts at this time.
- The concept projects for State Water were revised to be direct delivery project types.


# Post-Adoption Decision Process

Level 1 = De Minimis self-cert program, Non-De Minimis metering/monitoring and basin-wide voluntary water use efficiency programs

Level 2 = Mandatory pumping reductions in specific areas (may be accomplished by alternative means [i.e. groundwater conservation program and/or projects])

# Recommendation and Next Steps

- Recommend receiving and filing Draft Chapters
  - Begins public comment period (due July 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - GSAs individually comment, receive and file during public comment period
- GSA reps/staff review comments received and collectively provide responses to consultant
- Full Draft GSP published for next cycle of receive and file, and public comment (target date of August 8<sup>th</sup>)
