Direct Service Items:

Maximum allowable expense per client is \$500 per contract year.

Justified expenses can include:

- Household Items (such as furniture, cooking utensils, bedding, vacuum, etc.) Anything to make a household inhabitable.
- Items to Maintain or Gain Employment (clothing, shoes, haircut, tools, etc.)
- Health and Sanitary Items (eye glasses, toiletry kits, non-cosmetic dental work)
- Personal Identification Documents (CA drivers license, birth certificates, etc.)
- Travel/Transportation (minor vehicle repair, DMV registration, bus vouchers) Registered owner of vehicle must be PRTS client. **No gas vouchers.**
- Please contact your Case Manager Specialist if you have any questions.
- Eligibility determined by compliance in program.





WHAT IS PRTS?

PRTS, or Post-Release Treatment Services, is a treatment program that lasts approximately 12 months as individually determined by each client's necessary level of care.

Both morning and evening classes are offered to help support our clients' schedule in finding work and re-entering successfully into society after being incarcerated.

Using evidence-based recovery classes, access to resources through case management, referrals to medication assisted treatment, detoxification, and mental health as needed—all components combined create a holistic treatment model to fit each client's unique needs.



SERVICE DETAILS

Treatment:

- ◆ Substance Abuse Treatment
 - Moral Reconciliation Therapy
 - Gender Specific
 - Trauma Informed Care
 - Early Recovery, Social Support, and Relapse Prevention
- ◆ Individual Treatment
- ◆ Case Management Services, including transportation *as available*.

Resources (other than SHP):

- ◆ Supportive Housing Assistance and Direct Service
- ◆ Sober Living / Housing
 - Moving towards Self Payment
- ◆ Referrals to Community Based Organizations
- ◆ Mental health and psychiatry
- ◆ Detoxification and Medication Assisted Treatment/ Suboxone and Naloxone



SUPPORTIVE HOUSING ASSISTANCE (SHP)

- ◆ Funds can only be used for client's rent, utilities, or security deposit.
- ◆ The maximum allowable amount per client per year is \$6,667.00 (this does not include sober living funds)
- ◆ Utilities: to establish service for gas, electric, water, propane, and garbage.
- ◆ Moving costs: This includes fees to allow a client to apply for housing rentals. Examples include application fees, security deposit fees, property keys, and rent.

- ◆ Eligibility determined by compliance in program.
