WHO CAN ATTEND?

This program is for pregnant and parenting women (and their dependent children five and under) who have a history of drug and/or alcohol involvement. Each woman must be willing to be 100% drug and alcohol free.

ABOUT POEG

Meets four days per week. Each day will consist of a three-hour block of time. Services provided may include individual, family, group process, play therapy, as well as a parent support and education group. In addition, weekly recovery education and linkage with community resources such as W.I.C., CalWorks, Adult School, Family Planning, Medical Referrals, Center for Alternatives to Domestic Violence, GED Tutoring and Child Development Center.

Community resources will be included according to the participant's needs and requests, whenever possible.

In addition, any participant with special knowledge or skills relevant to enriching self development will be given the opportunity to share with the other POEG moms and kids.



CHILD SUPERVISION

On site supervision of children ages five and under is provided for women who may not otherwise be able to attend Perinatal Outpatient Extended Group (POEG). The children will participate in family socialization with their mother. Some children will be eligible for individual play therapy.

GOALS

To clarify the increased risks of alcohol and other drug use during pregnancy and breast feeding by providing a safe, positive, structured drug and alcohol free learning environment with focus on the family as a unit. Education about how drug and alcohol use affects the entire family. Learning alternative skills for achieving and maintaining a drug and alcohol free lifestyle will be ongoing.
