




Impervious Surface Areas

Projects that create or replace less than 2,500 square feet of impervious surface area must complete the Stormwater PCR Waiver Request Form.

Stormwater Control Plan Template






Stormwater Key Items

- As of today old forms will not be allowed to be submitted.
- Include all impervious areas on the application, i.e., driveways and hardscape. And if necessary submit an exhibit to justify net impervious areas.
- Make sure the selected Site Design Measure is presented on the plans.




Stormwater Dry Well or Infiltrator Registration
