WHAT IS IHSS CAREER PATHWAYS?

The In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Career Pathways Program is an optional program that provides training opportunities for IHSS/WPCS providers who have successfully completed provider enrollment. IHSS Providers who attend these training courses can be compensated for time spent attending and completing training courses.

- Participation is free
- Providers are paid hourly for attending classes
- Additional Incentive payments (\$500 - \$2,000) for completing courses
- Access to free coaching

COURSES

Courses offered by the IHSS Career Pathways Program include:

- Instructor-led online
- Online self-paced
- In person

Specialized course topics include:

- Assistance with transfers
- Ambulation
- Paramedical
- Protective Supervision related to mental impairment
- Trainings for providers who assist recipients living with:
 - Mental health challenges
 - Autism
 - Brain injuries
