Public Comment:

- Mike Bossenberry: May is Mental Health Awareness Month. Hope Walks Here event is on Saturday at Cal Poly to support suicide prevention efforts. Monday May 1st is Journey of Hope event with a focus on youth psychosis and mass trauma. Annual art show "Opening Minds" begins on May 5th at The Bunker coffee shop.
- Nancy Puder: SeaCoast Seniors has free educational seminars to help homeowners age in place.
- Jerry Mihaic: The Film Festival is ongoing in SLO and hopefully more seniors will be involved in these cultural events.

Members and guests introduced their role in the community as well as with the Commission.

Approve 03/22/23 Minutes: Motion by Anita Shower was made to accept minutes with corrections as noted. Paulina Flores Jimenez seconded the motion. All in favor – passed unanimously.

<u>Presentation:</u> Michelle Zulim-Clark - Strength and Balance Techniques for Fall Prevention and Healthy Aging

- Fall prevention program was a new program for County Public Health as of 2016/17
- Initially it was a four-week program, but has since been expanded to a six-week program to include more topics
- Community indicated a desire for more movement and exercise in these classes and Public Health was able to fulfill this in their program

- The Fall Prevention Program can be either six-weeks or single workshops and covers topics such as: home safety, medication management, stress, nutrition for bone health, sleep, brain health, vision and hearing loss
- Scheduling is best accomplished by reaching out directly to Michelle Zulim-Clark, as it
 is not a reoccurring course but is organized as needed
- Free home assessments are provided to identify areas around the house which can be improved for safety
- A greater emphasis on brain health will be added to fall prevention classes
- Some program materials will be available in Spanish as well
- A monthly newsletter provides tips and updates on brain health and healthy aging
- Michelle provided a hands-on demonstration of strength and balance techniques, including: balancing on one foot, walking heel to toe both forwards and backwards, "sneaky" walk, back leg raises, side leg raises, front leg raises, "clock" taps, heel raises, sit-to-stand, arm circles, wall pushups, ankle circles, and more.
