

- We will use consensus-based decision making.



Fiscal Report

- FY 2016-17 updated budget is \$16.2M (MHSA \$12.3M/Other Revenue \$3.9M)
 - CSS \$12.1M
 - PEI \$2.4M
 - INN \$633K
 - WET \$183K
 - CFTN (Electronic Health Record Support) \$877K
- Prudent Reserve Balances:
 - CSS \$2,745,458
 - PEI \$67,608
- MHSA Interest Balance is \$667,413
 - Reported on Annual Revenue & Expenditure Report by component
 - No specific regulations on interest
 - Propose using "as needed" prior to using prudent reserve
