Justification:

- Sustain 1.0 FTE Clinician located at 40 Prado Homeless Services Center
- 1.0 FTE Clinician will provide Homeless Service Center residents with behavioral health evaluations and treatment services and linkages/referrals to services. Additionally, the clinician will provide training to Homeless Services Center staff regarding assisting individuals with mental health and substance use disorders.

Outcomes:

- Minimum of 150 Homeless Service Center residents will receive on-site behavioral health evaluation and treatment services/linkages per year
- Homeless Services Center staff will receive a minimum of 4 training sessions per year to expand their working knowledge of helpful interventions in assisting individuals with mental health and substance use disorders
- Homeless Services Center staff will report increased skill in de-escalating resident disturbances (40% from prior year) resulting from individuals with mental health or substance use disorders
