


Background & Reasons for Project

- Only road to Port & Diablo Canyon.
- Subject to collapse during an earthquake
- Based on PG&E study, this bridge identified
- Assure evacuation route.
- We have all permits/clearances just waiting on final funding.



Impacts & Work to be Done Under the Bridge




- Begins June 15 -- Ends October 31
- Pedestrian access will be provided at all times
- Chevron begins by removing 5 abandoned pipes
- County's Contractor:
 - ✓ Repairs 2 pierwall jackets
 - ✓ Installs shear keys & cable restrainers above.

Chevron will Remove Abandoned Pipes Two Unsound Pierwall Jackets to be Removed & Replaced



Impacts & Work to be Done on Top of Bridge




- Begins after the Labor Day Holiday & can last 4 months.
- Only single lane closures (never both lanes).
 - ✓ During off peak hours
 - ✓ No night work
 - \checkmark No work during weekends or holidays.
- Bicycle & pedestrian traffic maintained at all times during construction.

Work window during day w. anticipated maximum 10-min delays


