**PURSUANT TO WELFARE & INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTION 827 AND 10850**: Juvenile court records are confidential. You may not disseminate, reveal or share this information in any way. If you are allowed to request copies of the information contained in this file, it is illegal for you to distribute, share or publish any of the materials. If you no longer need the documents, you are required to destroy them.

Anyone who reveals, disseminates, shares or otherwise violates the confidentiality of these records is guilty of a misdemeanor, pursuant to Penal Code Section 11167.5(a) which is punishable by imprisonment in the county jail for up to six (6) months, by a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) or by both imprisonment and fine.
