	the recommendation ready to go before the Full		
	Homeless Services Oversight Council in January		
	2020. A typical contract costs about \$70,000.		
	Laurel explained how extensive the process is		
	that includes census tracks to plan routes for the		
	count to ensure coverage as well as preventing		
	duplicated counting. The group talked about the		
	guides and surveyors that have been included in		

past years and the cost that's incurred when they have assisted. The group discussed how the previous year's contractor has Applied Survey Research (ASR) has assisted with the count. The group discussed ways to improve future counts. Mark suggested additional guides in North County. Laurel explained that an additional outreach person is being added to El Camino Homeless Organizations (ECHO) staff that may help increase relationships with individuals in that area. The group also discussed working more closely with North County Connections. The group discussed having a contractor again for the 2021 count. The group discussed other Counties methods around the count. The group also discussed the importance of multiple launch locations in each region.

3.2 Discussion Item: Continuum of Care Reports Schedule

Laurel informed the group about the Continuum of Care Reports Schedule. There are a number of reports coming up over the next several months. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is requiring a Longitudinal System Analysis (LSA) and well as the System Performance Measure (SPM) reports coming due in the Spring. The group discussed the importance of the housing placement date and what has happened to negatively alter the data. The reports also look at missing data. The group discussed data quality issues that they run into at their agencies.
