As part of our commitment to ensuring the integrity and accuracy of our elections, we are required to conduct Logic and Accuracy (L&A) testing of our voting equipment prior to each election. This process is crucial in verifying that the ballot counting program is correctly reading, tabulating, and reporting votes. Additionally, we perform audits postelection (1% Manual Tally) to further guarantee the accuracy of the results.

We are scheduled to commence our state-mandated Logic and Accuracy Testing on Friday, January 26th, starting at 9:00 am. The testing is anticipated to wrap up no later than 4:00 pm (it could always end sooner). This process provides an excellent opportunity for those who are interested to observe our commitment to election integrity firsthand.

Please note that due to space constraints in our elections area, we must limit the number of observers. During the actual testing, the observation will be somewhat limited for security reasons. Observers are required to stay in designated areas and will not be allowed access to the secured tabulation area, commonly referred to as "the fishbowl."

The certification is scheduled for Tuesday, January 30th, at 10:00 am. We anticipate this process to take approximately 2 hours.

Both the testing and certification will take place in our Elections Office located at 1055 Monterey St, Ste D-120, San Luis Obispo.
