STEPS TO ACCESS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Step 1:

Call 1-800-838-1381

This is our toll-free, 24 hour, 7 days-per-week Central Access Line. You will receive information about how to get Mental Health or Substance Use Disorder treatment services. If you call between 8 AM and 6 PM Monday through Friday (except holidays), we will schedule a first assessment appointment with you to discuss your needs and to help you find services that will work for you.

Step 2:

After completing an assessment, we will explain the services you qualify for and help you find providers who are available to work with you. You may read about our services and programs in this Provider List or on our website to help us find what you need.

- ✓ All clinic locations comply with ADA requirements and are wheelchair accessible
- ✓ All clinic locations are accepting new clients
- ✓ All clinics provide services in English and Spanish
- ✓ Other spoken language needs can be met as needed by contract with Language Line
- ✓ American Sign Language is available as needed at all sites
- ✓ Behavioral Health staff complete mandatory annual cultural competence training

Staff at Behavioral Health Clinics have specialized training to assist with a wide variety concerns that impact recovery. Staff are sensitive to culture, gender, and sexual identity. Only licensed, registered, waived, or certified treatment providers are listed on this Provider Directory. Provider assignment decisions will be made by considering availability, specialization, recommendations, and requests. Requests to work with a specific provider will be reviewed and authorized when possible.

*Replacement therapy is an evidence-based, medically supervised procedure, in which a longer acting opioid such as Methadone or buprenorphine (Suboxone) is prescribed as a substitute for an illegal opioid (e.g., heroin) or prescribed medication (e.g. Oxycodone). The medication used in replacement therapy has a dual purpose – it not only blocks the effects of other opioids, but also relieves cravings and withdrawal symptoms. While the medication can cause physiological dependence, it helps prevent other dangerous long-term health problems caused by drug abuse.

Network Providers:

Network Providers work closely with Behavioral Health to provide medication support services for full scope Medi-Cal beneficiaries only. All of our providers complete Cultural Competency trainings. Network Providers are available by referral from a Drug and Alcohol clinic only.

Please do not call them to begin treatment without a referral from County of San Luis Obispo Behavioral Health. All initial appointments must be pre-authorized by Behavioral Health.
