Funds will be taken from reserves as discussed during the August Commission meeting. The reserves include the \$4.7 million settlement funds from 2023.

1. CALL TO ORDER

3. REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

Janssen offered correction of minutes from the August 24, 2023, to include District (20%): Vicki Janssen (Alternate), Legislative Assistant as a Commissioner Present at Roll Call. Jones motioned for approval of amended minutes and seconded by Francis, approved.

4. COMMISSION ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: None

5. UTILITIES DIVISION REPORT:

Wright provided a first quarter operations budget report for Fiscal Year 23-24. No comments.

- Engelskirger reported normal operations aside from broken pipeline to City of SLO.
- Capacity at Lake Nacimiento as of last Thursday is 57%.
- Tesla battery at Rocky Canyon installed, waiting for PGE inspection (no timeline). In process for intake plans (no timeline).
- Temporary construction easement to install restraint joints is in process. Temporary pipeline will be removed and stored by end of year, then reinstalled with restraint joints in the spring to supply City of SLO during dry season.
- Permanent Repair Alternative 4 is moving forward; Permission to survey has been granted and Geotechnical report has been completed and we will move forward with design.

- We expect to be notified in January if the approximately \$1M Hazard Mitigation Grant Application for Flood Study in area of Nacimiento Pipeline has been approved. The study will identify any risks and mitigation recommendations.
- Approval for 2024 calendar requested. Francis motioned for approval and seconded by Jones, approved.

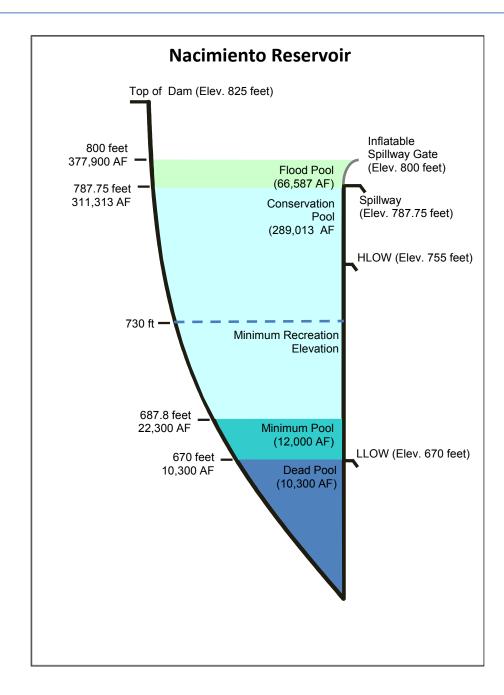


Figure 1. Schematic of Nacimiento Reservoir Pools

Figures summarizing the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Second Quarterly Operating Fund Budget are provided for your information. With 50% of the year elapsed, total expenditures and purchase order commitments are at 32.1% of budget. This includes non-routine projects that fluctuate during the fiscal year. More notably, annual Routine Operations and Maintenance efforts are at less than budgeted levels at 27.3% of the budget.
