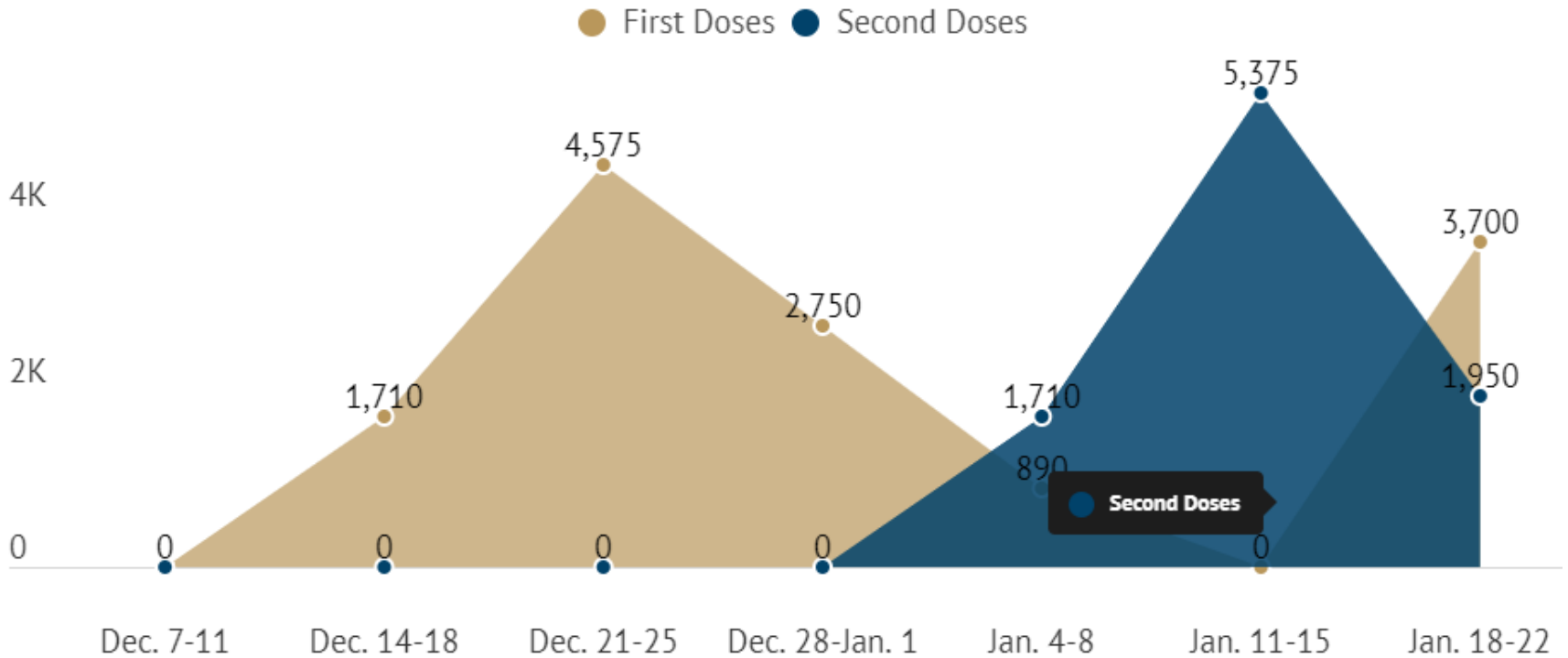

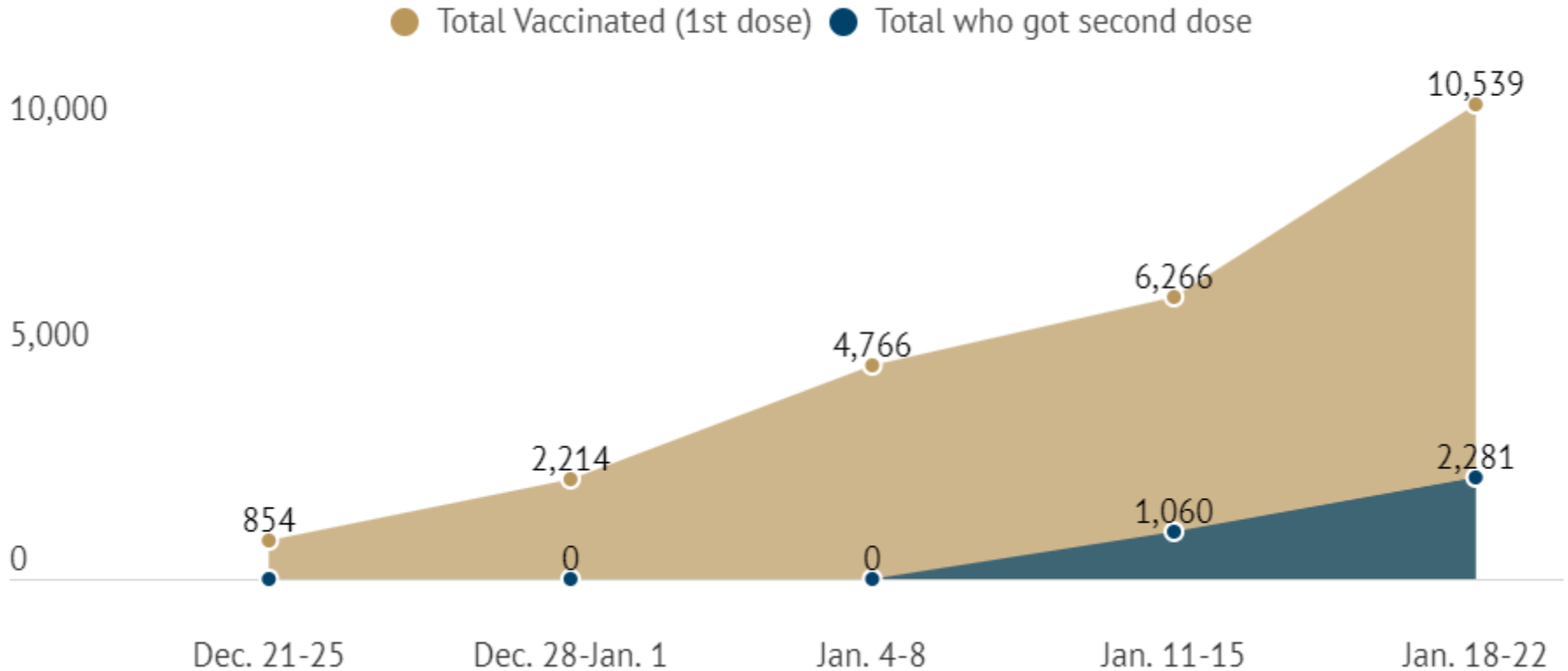
Weekly Vaccine Shipments to SLO County Public Health*

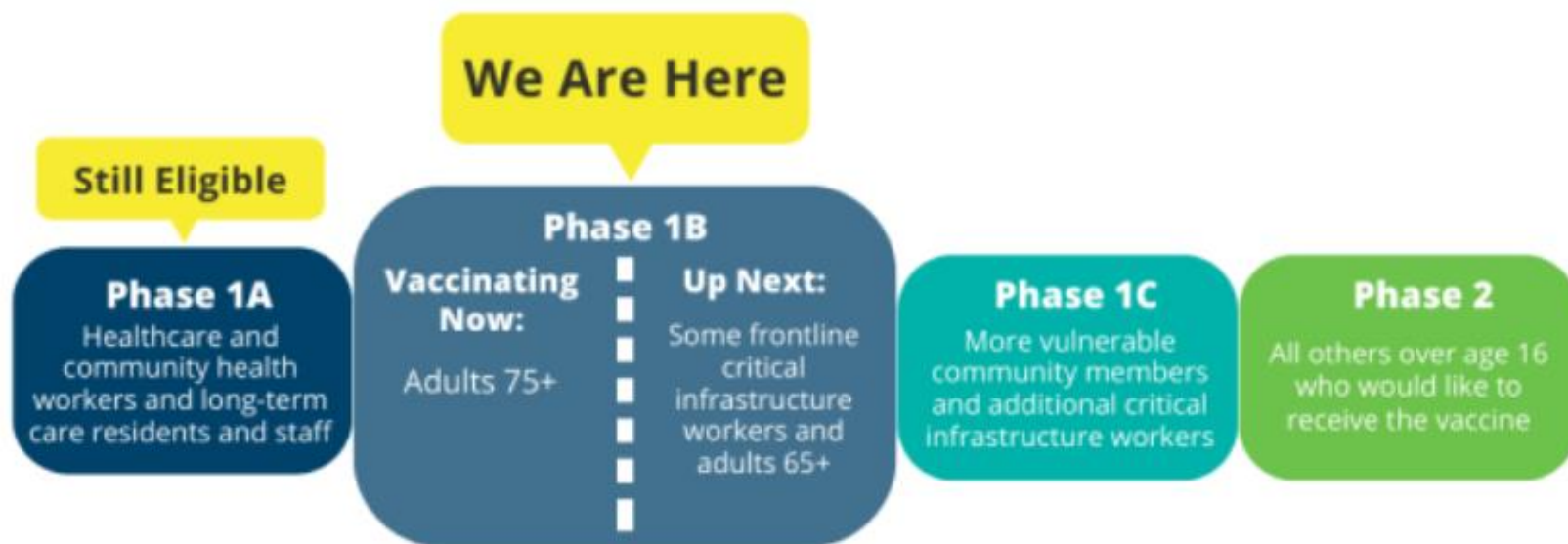

 - Education and Childcare
 - Emergency Services (Corrections staff)
 - Food and Agriculture (Food Bank)

Added South County site (AGHS)

Mobility issues

- In-car vaccinations and observation
- Cuesta College – capacity for drive through
- SLORTA free rides to vaccine sites



Who is being left behind?

How to reach the most vulnerable of the 75+ group

- Community partnerships
- Advocates/registration assistants
- In-reach



Surplus Doses

- New, on-call system for approved groups outside of 75+ age group

Vaccine Registration Challenges

Current Registration process

- Scheduling one week in advance, dependent on supply
- Online or by phone
- 4,000 appointments full within 2 hours



Potential Vaccine Registration Solution

Lottery registration process

- Interested eligible people pre-register
- Lottery is drawn weekly
- Names selected are invited to schedule their appointment

- Point in time scheduling
- Heavily impacted

- Pre-registration
- Standby pool
