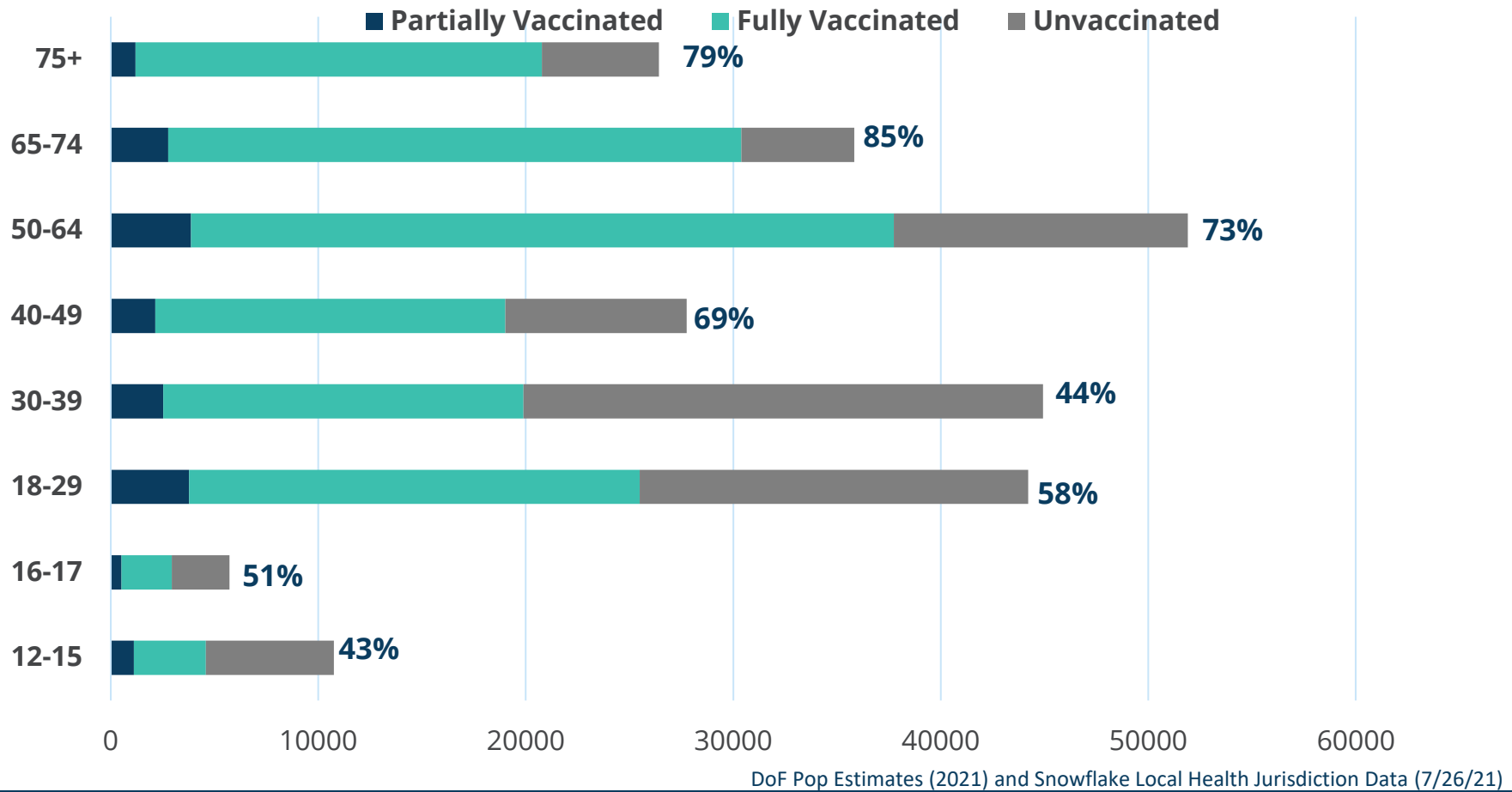


Delta Variant in CA

- 75% of specimens tested in CA are Delta
- Hospitalizations in CA have tripled in past month
- Avg age of hospitalizations dropped from 63 to 51

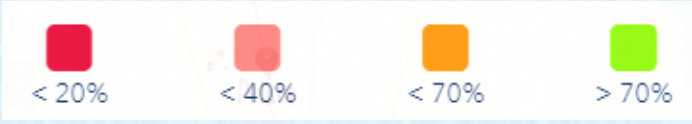

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Youth Vaccines (12-17)

- Virtual Vaccine Q&A with Pediatricians for Parents
 - In partnership with County Office of Education
- Mobile Vaccine Clinics at Back-to-School events
 - Doctor on-site to respond to parents' questions.



Cal Poly Outreach

- Student Vaccine Ambassadors to canvas on and off campus, in partnership with
 - Campus Health and Wellbeing
 - PULSE Peer Health Educators
 - Public Health Club
- Mobile Vaccine Clinics at SLO Days in Sept
- Watching CSU system and EUA status



Healthcare Providers

- Long Term Care facilities – Karen Jones
 - Education targeted to staff concerns
 - On site vaccination
- CHC - Dr. Clarke
 - Expanding vaccine to nearly all clinics + will begin administering Pfizer by end of Aug
 - Will ask each patient about vaccination at every visit
 - Text or audio message campaign to unvaccinated patients
- CenCal - Rachael Ponce
 - Targeted text message campaign to unvaccinated members
- Onboarding pediatric practices and adult medicine – Dr. Borenstein
 - Refrigeration & digital data loggers
 - Technical support in CA Vax
 - Survey to primary care providers



State Health Officer Order

Health Care Facilities & Congregate Care Settings have new requirements effective 8/9:

1. Proof of vaccination status required of staff
2. Masking requirements updated
3. Mandatory testing of unvaccinated staff
