





The SLO County Elections Office is holding its first-ever "I Voted" sticker design contest, which is open to students in **grades 3-6** and **grades 7-12**. The winning design in each division will be printed and distributed at polling places throughout San Luis Obispo County, and it will also be featured on the Clerk-Recorder's website and in outreach for the November 5, 2024, General Election.

Entries can be submitted in person, by mail, or via email **between July 3 and August 21**. The two winning designs will be announced in September.

Both hand-rendered and digital artwork will be accepted, as long as it adheres to the following rules and is formatted as a circle. Now let's see that SLO County creativity!

Contest Rules

- Design must be a circle (see Helpful Tips below)
- Design must include the words "I Voted" or "Future Voter"
- Design must include **only original artwork** (no copyrighted material, clip art, or anything originally produced by someone other than the student submitting the entry)
- Design must be non-partisan and not reference any political party, group, or slogan
- Digital entries must be submitted as a jpeg and have a resolution of 300 dpi
- Hand-rendered art must be two-dimensional and on white paper
- Entries must be accompanied by a copy of this entry form, even if page 1 is not used
- Entries must be submitted via one of the following methods by 5pm on Wednesday, August 21, 2024:
