Examples of Documentary Transfer Tax ("DTT") Statements

Revenue & Taxation (R & T) Code Sections 11911 - 11933

Required Elements of a DTT Statement:

- 1) Must be located on first page of deed. (R & T Code 11932)
- 2) Declaratory language (e.g., "The undersigned declares...") (R & T Code 11933)
- 3) Amount of tax due -- if it is \$0, there must be an exemption code/wording stated. (R & T Code 11932)
- 4) If \$0, a Revenue & Taxation code/reason must be provided to support exemption of tax. See DTT Exemptions for exemption codes. (R & T Codes 11921 11930)
- 5) If tax is owed, basis of tax calculation (full value of property or full value minus liens remaining on property). If "less liens" is indicated, must have a recording reference to the loan being assumed. (R & T Code 11933)
- 6) Location of property (e.g., unincorporated area OR provide name of city) (R & T Code 11932)
- 7) Signature placement of signature depends on format (see below examples). (R & T Code 11933)
