# Juvenile Drug Court



## Drug Court

Phase 1: Stabilization

Phase 2: Recovery Plan and Life Skills Development

Phase 3: Ongoing Treatment

Phase 4: Expanded Life Skills/ Graduation Preparation

## Drug Court is:

- Four-phase program that is aimed at intervening in substance abuse and related delinquent behavior
- The Drug Court Probation Officer will help youth stay on track while completing requirements and each phase successfully

## Eligibility

Most minors are referred by their probation officer. Drug Court serves:

- 13-17 year olds
- Are a ward of the Juvenile Court
- Have no sustained felony sex offenses, felony violent offenses, or drug sales offenses
- Have moderate to severe drug or alcohol problems

## Graduation

Successful completion of each phase results in Graduation. It is hoped that juveniles continue their positive lifestyle changes and participate in support meetings, live clean and sober and strive towards their educational or vocational goals. The Juvenile Drug Court Team will continue to offer support and be a resource.

**Most importantly family and youth must be motivated to participate in the program and commit to the requirements**
