The Mobile Crisis Team (MCT) provides crisis services to individuals in the community who are experiencing acute distress and require a rapid response and urgent care. The goal is to assist the individual in stabilizing and remaining in their own environment, prevent the need for higher levels of care, and avoid unnecessary emergency department care and law enforcement call-outs.

The Mental Health Evaluation Team (MHET) provides crisis services at the local hospitals for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

The Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) is a 24-hour voluntary short-term care facility that provides immediate behavioral health support and treatment services, including:

- De-escalation of a person's level of distress
- Prevention or treatment of a behavioral health crisis
- Reduction of acute symptoms of a mental health condition
- Medication support and monitoring services
- Referrals, resources, and peer support advocacy
