


Service Dogs in Food Facilities Are animals allowed in my restaurant?

Service Dogs are allowed anywhere the public can go (including dining room)





Pet Dogs in Food Facilities Are animals allowed in my restaurant?

Pet Dogs are allowed on patios only if a restaurant owner allows it





California Law Allows Pet Dogs on Dining Patios at Restaurant Owner's Discretion

A law that took effect January 1, 2015 allows pet dogs to be in an outdoor dining area (patio) under certain circumstances. The following rules apply:

- It is up to the business owner whether or not dogs can be on their patio
- There must be a separate outdoor entrance so that pet dogs do not walk through the dining room
- Like service dogs, pet dogs are not allowed on chairs, seats or benches
- If food or water is provided to pet dogs, it must be provided in single-use disposable containers
- Food employees are prohibited from having direct contact with pet dogs while on duty.
- If a food employee does have prohibited contact, they must wash their hands immediately
- The patio area must be kept clean. Any surfaces, (including the floor) that has been contaminated by dog poop, pee, saliva or vomit must be cleaned and sanitized.
- The pet dog must be on a leash or confined in a pet carrier and under the control of the owner.
- The restaurant owner must comply with any local ordinances related to sidewalks, public nuisance, and sanitation.
