If a business or entity handles Acutely Hazardous Material (AHM) at or above the threshold planning quantities, they are required to submit a Risk Management Plan to the CUPA pursuant to California Health & Safety Code, Division 20, Chapter 6.95, Article 2 and California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Sections 2735 – 2785
