<b>What is the overall deductible?</b>	<b>\$250</b> per individual / <b>\$750</b> per family for participating providers.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</b>	Yes. Preventive care and services listed in your complete terms of coverage.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. <b>Are there other deductibles for specific services?</b>	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.

<b>What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?</b>	Copayments for certain services, prescription drug cost share out-of-network, any member prescription penalties (if applicable), premiums, balance-billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.
