Road Naming Petition

Instructions for circulating a road naming petition

In order to name or rename an existing road, this Road Naming Petition, accompanied by the Road Name Application (Form PLN-1010), must be completed and submitted to the Department of Planning & Building with any applicable fees. All petition information must be neatly printed, with the exception of signatures. Unfortunately, mistakes or omissions of the required information will delay processing the proposed road name.

Prior to circulating the petition, please contact your neighbors and mutually decide on three or more possible road names. To review the list of road names already in use (making them unavailable), please consult the Department's website at <http://www.sloplanning.org> or contact the Department at (805) 781-5600. Refer to the Road Naming User Guide (document PLN-2005) to ensure that the proposed road names meet required criteria. Once your neighbors and the Department have agreed on a road name, enter that name on the Road Name Application and Road Naming Petition forms and begin circulating the petition. You will need a majority (two-thirds or more) of owners of addressable structures and/or vacant parcels to sign the petition indicating their desire for the proposed road name. And please, gather only one signature for each property ownership.

Once the application is completed, and the petition properly circulated, you may submit the forms and applicable fees to the Department of Planning & Building.

Once the application and petition are received, staff will begin their review and schedule the proposed road name for a public hearing before the Hearing Officer.
