- SLO CHP New Commander Mike Brown provided a summary of recent Countywide bike collisions. February to Date 6 in total 4 solo cyclist at fault, 2 cyclist vs Cyclist, 2 cyclist vs Vehicle.
- Committee discussed availability and access bicycle collision data. Jake Hudson of County
 Public Works demonstrated the Transportation Injury Mapping System
 (https://tims.berkeley.edu/) for access to collision data.
- Myron "Skip" Amerine asked how to deal with vehicle parking in bike lanes, CHP responded that calling dispatch is the best option.

- Jim DeCecco discussed the issue of parking in bike lanes as related to two photo attachments to the Agenda, Jim indicated that he had contacted both the City of Pismo and CalTrans. The request for Caltrans to install park off pavement signs has officially been lodged with the State.

 - Jim DeCecco requested BAC review and coordination meeting for designs for community betterment grants and potential expansion for quick build at 19th and Wilmar intersection narrowing.

7. PRESENTATION (30 minutes max)

A. County Active Transportation Plan Update

- Jake Hudson of County Public Works Presented preliminary research on the State of Practice for County ATP in California.
 - 10% of Counties have no ATP or Bike/Pedestrian Plan, 20% have a Bike/Pedestrian Plan but no ATP, and 70% have an ATP.
 - Of the 70% of Counties that have an ATP; 60% have a comprehensive/consolidated ATP, and 40% have a high level Policy ATP with companion Bike/Pedestrian Plan.
 - San Luis Obispo County falls with in the 70% that have a regional ATP and the 40% that have a high level policy ATP with companion Bike/Pedestrian plan.
 - Anticipated Cost to convert to an ATP upwards of \$750,000 and expected time frame 3+ years.
- Committee requested a Special Joint Meeting of the BAC & Trails Committee.
- Jake Hudson of County Public Works stated that the draft staff recommendation to the Information on the Bicycle Advisory Committee, the SLO County Bikeways Plan, and prior meeting minutes and agenda are available online at:
