<b>1)</b>	<b>Welcome and Introductions</b>  Members in attendance; Gary Kobara, Charlie Lackie, and Dianna Lackie.  Others in attendance: Nathan Claud (Public Works), and Nola Engelskirger (Public Works); Mike Silva (public)
<b>2)</b>	<b>Public Comment – None</b>
<b>3)</b>	<b>Announcements</b> – The Oceano airport presented their master plan to widen the runway for FAA compliance. Nola noted that although drainage has not been addressed at this point the district will work with the airport to make sure that the account for the additional off site drainage.
<b>4)</b>	<b>Review and Approval of Past Minutes</b>  The March 2021 minutes were distributed a quorum was not present to approve.
<b>5)</b>	<b>Channel Maintenance</b>  County Staff Nathan Claud provided the following update: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nathan answered Mike Silvas question regarding the mowing of the outside slope of the levy near the Cienega Seebreeze park. A contractor is set up to perform mowing, a date has not been set. Nathan will get back to Mike with a date.</li><li>• The outer slopes of the south levy were sprayed with a selective herbicide. Mowing will take place soon.</li><li>• A test plot was cleared an planted near Creek road for the purpose of determining if a different hydroseed mix might be more successful.</li></ul>
<b>6)</b>	<b>AG Creek WMP Project Alt 3A and Mod. 3C Projects</b>  County Staff Nola Engelskirger provided the following project updates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The WMP is in its final stages of project closeout. The are collecting final invoices</li></ul>

	and submitting them for grant consideration. The as-builts are being finalized.
7)	<p><b>Meadow Creek Watershed Lagoon Restoration Plan</b></p> <p>County Staff Nola Engelskirger provided the following project updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The kickoff meeting for the Meadow Creek project was held. At this point their efforts are focused on data collection. They have reached out to partnering agencies for past studies and surveys. This will aid in design and avoid doubling efforts.</li> <li>• Once modeling is completed we will have a public meeting to present the options.</li> <li>• The preferred project for restoration is due November of 2022.</li> </ul>
8)	<p><b>Open Forum (Questions / Suggestions for next agenda)</b></p> <p>Gary Kobara asked if the Meadow Creek Project will take care of the mitigation requirements for the WMP. Will the WMP be considered complete at that point?</p> <p>Nola answered, Meadow Creek is a project alternative to the WMP. Restoring the lagoon is a condition of the WMP.</p> <p><i>Next meeting July, 20<sup>th</sup> 2021.</i></p>
