Hello!!

I, for one, am very appreciative of the wealth of relevant information that has been, and is being, submitted by David Broadwater, and am grateful it is being made available to WRAC members, and to members of the public who visit our website via slocountywater.org, so that we can have a foundation on which to make decisions.

Given the speed with which the need to take action on the current scoping has come at us, we have not been able to deal with it in our usual way: to convene a subcommittee, have the subcommittee go through the time-consuming work of hammering out issues for and language of proposed WRAC coments, have the subcommittee submit draft comment language into a WRAC agenda, and have WRAC members come to the meeting prepared to adopt, or adopt after modifying, the proposal in front of them.

In the case of the present scoping period, we were unable to agendize any action on this matter in November, and December is the only meeting at which we can take action before the deadline. This does not give us the option of creating a subcommittee that can work out the language of proposed correspondence from the WRAC.

Recognizing this, I am volunteering now as a sort of self-appointed subcommittee of one. In a separate e-mail soon to come your way, I will send a proposed letter to the Board of Supervisors from the WRAC that I would hope could be posted at our site, to serve as one possibility for action, or action with modification. I would hope any other WRAC member would feel free to propose a letter of their own, but whether or not this happens, we could have at least one tangible proposal as a basis for possible action, with or without modification, should the WRAC see fit to go that direction. This letter would be intended to be submitted to the Board with, as an attachment, the David Broadwater correspondence dated 11/19/15 at 11:00 am, entitled "SLO Co. Sewage Sludge Ordinance Policy--Wrong/Cease EIR process."

You will hear from me soon with the draft of a letter!!
