The attached *Historic Property Survey Report for the Dover Canyon Road at Jack Creek Bridge Replacement Project* documents that the requirements of 36 CFR 800 have been fulfilled, in accordance with the January 1, 2014 *First Amended Programmatic Agreement Among the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, the California State Historic Preservation Officer, and the California Department of Transportation* (Programmatic Agreement).

Caltrans, under the authority of FHWA has made a finding of No Historic Properties Affected, and no further studies are warranted. In the event cultural material is encountered during construction, work shall cease until a qualified archaeologist can assess the unanticipated discovery in accordance with the Programmatic Agreement, and the Caltrans Environmental Planning Branch shall be notified immediately.
