

GRANT OF EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMMENCE COLLECTION OF FOOD WASTE AS A RECYCLABLE MATERIAL

Pursuant to and in accordance with Article 5.1.2.2.1 and Article 5.1.2.2.3 of the SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FRANCHISE AGREEMENT between the County of San Luis Obispo, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and Mid-State Solid Waste and Recycling Services, Inc., a California corporation ("Franchisee") effective June 17, 2014 ("Agreement"), the County has determined that Franchisee has submitted documentation demonstrating that Franchisee's failure to meet the June 17, 2016 deadline to commence collection of Food Waste as a Recyclable Material is through no fault of Franchisee. Specifically, Franchisee has been diligently working with CalRecycle to obtain the necessary permits and on completing all necessary environmental review. Based on the foregoing, the County hereby grants Franchisee an extension of time to commence the collection of Food Waste that has been properly set out for collection by the generator within the Franchise Area as a Recyclable Material until on or before forty-eight (48) months following the Effective Date of the Agreement (June 17, 2018). Except as specifically provided herein, all obligations of Franchisee, including, without limitation, all obligations set forth in Article 5.1.2 of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
