



# How to comment on the San Luis Obispo County Final Draft Post-Construction Stormwater Guidebook

Each word document is available online for download. The documents are locked for editing and cannot be modified using traditional editing or track changes methods.

- Comments can be made in response to specific lines of each document using the 'New Comment' feature in the Review Tab.

**There are two (2) methods for adding a new comment on a specific line:**
