surrounding communities of interest

Dear Supervisors:

We are concerned about your recent decision to redistrict the County of San Luis Obispo whereby Santa Margarita has been excised from all its surrounding local communities of interest and placed in a district with Templeton and Paso Robles. As a community hub it is essential that Santa Margarita and surrounding areas remain together as a region defined as communities of interest and represented by one supervisor, not three.

The redistricting map you favor has removed Santa Margarita Ranch, Santa Margarita Lake, Garden Farms, Pozo, Tassajara Canyon, Parkhill Road, Rinconada from one same district, all of which are clearly viewed as communities of interest to Santa Margarita for a variety of reasons. They all travel on Highway 58 and El Camino corridors as general motorists and commuters, a 3 million grant was recently awarded to County Parks to fund a pedestrian trail from Garden Farms to Santa Margarita around the perimeter of the SM Ranch, Santa Margarita has established an emergency water pipeline with Atascadero, and most importantly how future housing and commercial development that includes water and septic issues affects the entire region.

We believe it is in the best interest of Santa Margarita and surrounding communities to remain in the same district with one supervisor rather than three. Thank you for your reconsideration on this matter.
