20 The District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the
21 above named defendant of the following criminal offenses:

22 Count 1

23 On or about February 23, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
24 crime of Assault Upon Peace Officer Or Firefighter in violation of PC245(c), a Felony, was
25 committed in that LAURA LEE MILLAR did willfully and unlawfully commit an assault with a
26 deadly weapon and instrument and by force likely to produce great bodily injury upon the
27 person of Jeffrey Corral when said defendant, LAURA LEE MILLAR knew and should have
28

1 known that said person was a peace officer then and there engaged in the performance of
2 his/her duties .

3 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section
4 1192.7(c).

5 Enhancement

6 PC12022.7(a): Spec Alleg-Great Bodily Injury

7 It is further alleged as to Count 1 that in the commission of the above offense the said
8 defendant, LAURA LEE MILLAR, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Jeffrey
9 Corral, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section
10 12022.7(a) and also causing the above offense to become a serious felony within the
11 meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8).

12 NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal
13 Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8)

14 Count 2

15 On or about February 23, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
16 crime of Leaving The Scene Of An Accident in violation of VC20001(a), a Felony, was
17 committed in that LAURA LEE MILLAR did unlawfully, and knowingly, being a driver of a
18 vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to a person other than herself, fail, refuse,
19 and neglect to give to the injured person and to a traffic and police officer at the scene of
20 the accident her name and address, the registration number of her vehicle, and the name
21 of the owner of said vehicle; to exhibit her operator's license; to render reasonable
22 assistance to the injured person; and perform the duties specified in Vehicle Code
23 Sections 20003 and 20004.

24 Count 3

25 On or about February 23, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
26 crime of Driving Under The Influence Of Alcohol Causing Injury in violation of VC23153(A),
27 a Felony, was committed in that LAURA LEE MILLAR did unlawfully, while under the
28 influence of an alcoholic beverage, drive a vehicle and in so driving, concurrently did an

1 act forbidden by law and neglected a duty imposed by law which proximately caused
2 bodily injury to Jeffrey Corral.

3 Enhancement

4 PC12022.7(a): Spec Alleg-Great Bodily Injury

5 It is further alleged as to Count 3 that in the commission of the above offense the said
6 defendant, LAURA LEE MILLAR, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Jeffrey
7 Corral, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section
8 12022.7(a) and also causing the above offense to become a serious felony within the
9 meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8).

10 NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal
11 Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8)

12 Count 4

13 On or about February 23, 2023, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
14 crime of Driving With A .08% Blood Alcohol Causing Injury in violation of VC23153(b), a
15 Felony, was committed in that LAURA LEE MILLAR did unlawfully while having .08
16 percent and more, by weight, of alcohol in his/her blood, drive a vehicle and in so driving
17 did an act forbidden by law and neglected a duty imposed by law which proximately
18 caused bodily injury to Jeffrey Corral.

19 Enhancement

20 PC12022.7(a): Spec Alleg-Great Bodily Injury

21 It is further alleged as to Count 4 that in the commission of the above offense the said
22 defendant, LAURA LEE MILLAR, personally inflicted great bodily injury upon Jeffrey
23 Corral, not an accomplice to the above offense, within the meaning of Penal Code Section
24 12022.7(a) and also causing the above offense to become a serious felony within the
25 meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8).

26 NOTICE: This offense is a serious felony and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal
27 Code sections 1192.7(c)(8) and 667.5(c)(8)

1 It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code Section 1170(b)(2) that one or more of the
2 following factors in aggravation listed in California Rule of Court 4.421 may apply to the
3 defendant(s) or to conduct of the defendant(s):

4 4.421(a)(1) The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily
5 harm, and other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness and callousness.

6 4.421(a)(2) The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the
7 commission of the crime.

8 4.421(a)(3) The victim was particularly vulnerable.

9 4.421(a)(4) The defendant induced others to participate in the commission of the crime
10 and occupied a position of leadership and dominance of other participants in its
11 commission.

12 4.421(a)(5) The defendant induced a minor to commit and assist in the commission of the
13 crime.

14 4.421(a)(6) The defendant threatened witnesses, unlawfully prevented and dissuaded
15 witnesses from testifying, suborned perjury, and in any other way illegally interfered with
16 the judicial process.

17 4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive sentences
18 can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.

19 4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning,
20 sophistication, and professionalism.

21 4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary
22 value.

23 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.

24 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to commit
25 the offense.

26 4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal Code
27 and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall be
28

1 imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the Penal
2 Code.

3 4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger
4 to society.

5 4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in
6 juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.

7 4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under section
8 1170(h).

9 4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release
10 community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.

11 4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post
12 release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.
