19 The District Attorney of the San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the
20 above named defendant of the following criminal offenses:

21 Count 1

22 On or about November 4, 2018, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
23 crime of Assault To Commit A Felony During The Commission Of A First Degree Burglary
24 in violation of PC220(b), a Felony, was committed in that JASON LAMONT FENWICK did
25 during the commission of a first degree burglary assault Confidential Victim, with the intent
26 to commit rape, sodomy, oral copulation and a violation of sections 264.1, 288, and 289.

27 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code
28 section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

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AMENDED INFORMATION

1 NOTICE: The above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code 667.5(c).
2 NOTICE: Being charged with this criminal offense can result in mandatory pre-conviction
3 HIV/AIDS testing and disclosure of the results to a victim and the Chief Medical Officer of
4 the jail or prison facility where you are incarcerated pursuant to Penal Code Section
5 1524.1 and Health and Safety Code section 121055 following a probable cause hearing
6 resulting in a court order.

7 NOTICE: Adjudication as a ward of the court for this offense and a disposition to the
8 California Youth Authority will require you to provide specimens and samples pursuant to
9 Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime.

10 Count 2

11 On or about November 4, 2018, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the
12 crime of Oral Copulation By Anesthesia Or Controlled Substance in violation of PC288A(i),
13 a Felony, was committed in that JASON LAMONT FENWICK did unlawfully commit an act
14 of oral copulation upon Confidential Victim who was prevented from resisting by an
15 intoxicating, anesthetic and controlled substance and this condition was known, and
16 reasonably should have been known by the defendant.

17 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require the court to order you to submit to a blood
18 test for evidence of antibodies to the probable causative agent of Acquired Immune
19 Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). Penal Code Section 1202.1.

20 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code
21 section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

22 NOTICE: Being charged with this criminal offense can result in mandatory pre-conviction
23 HIV/AIDS testing and disclosure of the results to a victim and the Chief Medical Officer of
24 the jail or prison facility where you are incarcerated pursuant to Penal Code Section
25 1524.1 and Health and Safety Code section 121055 following a probable cause hearing
26 resulting in a court order.

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Count 3

On or about November 4, 2018, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Sexual Penetration By Foreign Object in violation of PC289(e), a Felony, was committed in that JASON LAMONT FENWICK committed an act of sexual penetration against Confidential Victim when said victim was prevented from resisting by an intoxicating and anesthetic substance, and a controlled substance, this being known, and reasonably should have been known, by defendant.

NOTICE: Adjudication as a ward of the court for this offense and a disposition to the California Youth Authority will require you to provide specimens and samples pursuant to Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime.

NOTICE is hereby given that adjudication as a ward of the Court for this offense and a disposition to the California Youth Authority will require you to register pursuant to Section 290 of the Penal Code. Willful failure to register is a felony.

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

NOTICE: Being charged with this criminal offense can result in mandatory pre-conviction HIV/AIDS testing and disclosure of the results to a victim and the Chief Medical Officer of the jail or prison facility where you are incarcerated pursuant to Penal Code Section 1524.1 and Health and Safety Code section 121055 following a probable cause hearing resulting in a court order.

Count 4

On or about November 4, 2018, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the crime of Unauthorized Invasion Of Privacy in violation of PC647(J)(2), a Misdemeanor, was committed in that JASON LAMONT FENWICK did unlawfully use a concealed camcorder, motion picture camera, and photographic camera to secretly videotape, film, photograph, and record by electronic means another identifiable person to wit, Confidential Victim, under and through the clothing being worn by that other person, for the purpose of viewing the body of and the undergarments worn by that other person without the consent


1 and knowledge of the other person and with the intent to arouse, appeal to and gratify the
2 lust, passions and sexual desires of that person and invade the privacy of that other
3 person under circumstances in which the other person has a reasonable expectation of
4 privacy.

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1 Contrary to the form, force and effect of that statute in such cases made and
2 provided and against the peace and dignity of the people of the State of California.
