20 The District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the  
21 above-named defendant of the following criminal offenses:

22 Count 1

23 On or about September 7, 2024, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the  
24 crime of Assault To Commit A Felony During The Commission Of A First Degree Burglary  
25 in violation of PC220(b), a Felony, was committed in that ALEXIS ALEJANDRO did during  
26 the commission of a first degree burglary assault Confidential Victim, with the intent to

1 commit rape, sodomy, oral copulation or any violation of sections 264.1, 288, or 289.

3 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code  
4 section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

5 NOTICE: The above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code 667.5(c).

6 NOTICE: Being charged with this criminal offense can result in mandatory pre-conviction  
7 HIV/AIDS testing and disclosure of the results to a victim and the Chief Medical Officer of  
8 the jail or prison facility where you are incarcerated pursuant to Penal Code Section 1524.1  
9 and Health and Safety Code section 121055 following a probable cause hearing resulting in  
10 a court order. and NOTICE: Being charged with this criminal offense can result in  
11 mandatory pre-conviction HIV/AIDS testing and disclosure of the results to a victim and the  
12 Chief Medical Officer of the jail or prison facility where you are incarcerated pursuant to  
13 Penal Code Section 1524.1 and Health and Safety Code section 121055 following a  
14 probable cause hearing resulting in a court order.

16 Count 2

17 On or about September 7, 2024, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the  
18 crime of Assault With Intent To Commit A Felony in violation of PC220(a)(1), a Felony, was  
19 committed in that ALEXIS ALEJANDRO did unlawfully assault Confidential Victim, with the  
20 intent to commit rape, sodomy, oral copulation, or any violation of sections 264.1, 288, or  
21 289.

22  
23 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code  
24 section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

25 NOTICE: The above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code 667.5(c).

1 NOTICE: Adjudication as a ward of the court for this offense and a disposition to the  
2 California Youth Authority will require you to provide specimens and samples pursuant to  
3 Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime.

4 Count 3

5 On or about September 7, 2024, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the  
6 crime of First Degree Burglary, Person Present in violation of PC459, a Felony, was  
7 committed in that ALEXIS ALEJANDRO did enter an inhabited dwelling house occupied by  
8 Confidential Victim, with the intent to commit larceny or any felony.

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10 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section  
11 1192.7(c).

12  
13 It is further alleged that the above offense is a violation of Penal Code Section 462(a).

14  
15 It is further alleged that the above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of Penal  
16 Code 667.5(c) in that another person, other than an accomplice, was present in the  
17 residence during the commission of the above offense.

18  
19 It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code Section 1170(b)(2) that one or more of the  
20 following factors in aggravation listed in California Rule of Court 4.421 may apply to the  
21 defendant(s) or to conduct of the defendant(s):

22 4.421(a)(1) The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily  
23 harm, and other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness and callousness.

24 4.421(a)(2) The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the  
25 commission of the crime.

26 4.421(a)(3) The victim was particularly vulnerable.  
27  
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1 4.421(a)(4) The defendant induced others to participate in the commission of the crime  
2 and occupied a position of leadership and dominance of other participants in its  
3 commission.

4 4.421(a)(5) The defendant induced a minor to commit and assist in the commission of  
5 the crime.

6 4.421(a)(6) The defendant threatened witnesses, unlawfully prevented and dissuaded  
7 witnesses from testifying, suborned perjury, and in any other way illegally interfered with  
8 the judicial process.

9 4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive  
10 sentences can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.

11 4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning,  
12 sophistication, and professionalism.

13 4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great  
14 monetary value.

15 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.

16 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to  
17 commit the offense.

18 4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal  
19 Code and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall  
20 be imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the  
21 Penal Code.

22 4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious  
23 danger to society.

24 4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in  
25 juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.

26 4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under  
27 section 1170(h).

28

1 4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release  
2 community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.

3 4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision,  
4 post release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.

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1 All of which is contrary to the statute in such cases made and provided, and against  
2 the peace and dignity of the People of the State of California.


3 I declare that an investigation has been conducted to determine if said
